



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Milford Municipal Utilities of Milford, Iowa will be holding a Public Hearing to review an application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document and the MMU's project plan. These documents include design and environmental information related to the proposed improvements to the drinking water treatment plant.

The proposed project includes the construction of a new conventional filtration water treatment facility with coagulation, flocculation, sedimentation, filtration, and disinfection. This will include new flocculation and sedimentation tanks, new filters, converting the existing clearwell into a CT tank, new 450,000 gallon clearwell, new control and operations building, fencing entire complex, and all necessary electrical, controls, connections and appurtenances. The existing water treatment facility and some surrounding structures will be demolished and the new facility constructed at the existing site. The project also includes constructing a parallel section of raw water transmission line where it crosses beneath US-71 (approximately 230 LF of directional boring).

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to inform area residents of the community of Milford of this proposed action, discuss the actual cost and user fees associated with this project, and to address citizen's concerns, if any, with the plan.
